## **Why be a part of BDC's award winning Competition Team?**

On competition teams, dancers work on steps until mastered. This leads to a feeling of accomplishment and self-esteem. Also, attendance is more important and, at times, mandatory. Since everyone is present in class nearly every week, there is faster progress.

Most importantly, the opportunity to be challenged! There is a great feeling of accomplishment by doing quality work. Teamwork encourages strong social contacts/friendships, which can last a lifetime. And watching the routine unfold throughout the year is a fascinating process.

Things to consider:

### **Time**

- Your studio time will be increased. There may be more classes per week than you are used to taking with recreational classes. Some teams require more than one practice a week; others require extra classes like leaps & turns, ballet, technique, or acro.
- You will be committed to 4 regional competitions, 1 National, 1 in studio dance convention & 1 Ignite Convention
- Parents must attend periodic team meetings (i.e. make up, hair clinic). Team meetings also allow you to meet other parents, so you can get to know them
- Competition team members MUST (Junior, Teen & Senior) take classes during the summer.

### **Cost**

- Consider the tuition for the number of hours that will be required. (See tuition section)
- Consider the cost of costumes, which can range from \$125 to \$250 each.
- Costumes must be of a higher quality because (1) they are judged for excellence and originality and (2) they will be worn many times throughout the season.
- Competition Fees are approximately \$65-\$160 per routine per competition. Fees are due 6 weeks before each competition.  
There are extra studio fees: Prop/Transportation Fee
- Consider travel expenses, for example, gas to go to competitions, hotels.
- Team Jackets, Back Packs, and leggings

### **A. BDC Dress Code:**

Broadway Dance Co. believes that a student's attire greatly determines the attitude she/he holds regarding work rehearsal and recital. Therefore, we require that the standard of appropriate neatness and class-designated dress be observed at all times. General guidelines are as follows:

- Students dancewear should fit properly, it should not be too revealing or have any inappropriate message on it.
- Student's underwear should not be visible beneath his/her dance clothes. I.E. no bras showing, underwear, etc.
- Hair should be pulled away from the face; **mandatory bun/no bangs for all ballet classes.**
- Mandatory black leotard, pink tights and split sole ballet shoes (leather or canvas) for all ballet classes.
- Dance attire for all other classes should be leotard, tights, booty shorts, or dance top and pants.
- **No jewelry** may be worn in dance class, small stud earrings acceptable.
- Dance shoes should only be worn in dance class, they must be clean and debris free so as not to track dirt into the dance rooms.

### **B. BDC Studio Rules and Policies:**

- Dancers will respect the studio by not eating in the dance rooms. Designated areas are made available.
- Dancers will arrive at **least 10 minutes early** to all classes and rehearsals, so they are prepared to start when class begins
- Dancers will not engage in any curse language or bring any inappropriate material to the studio. This includes images on their phone.
- Anyone caught drinking alcohol, vaping or using any illegal drugs will be removed from the premises and the team.
- Dancers are not permitted to leave the building and walk to local restaurants unless a signed permission slip has been turned into the front desk.
- **Dancers will submit a vacation notification form, 2 weeks prior to dancer missing a rehearsal due to a vacation.**
- Dancers understand that if he/she does not attend the last rehearsal before a competition they **will not** be able to perform at that competition. No refunds will be provided.
- Dancers will attend all dance classes at a convention and realize while in those classes, that he/she is expected to act respectfully because they represent Broadway Dance Co.
- Teachers have final judgments to remove a dance from competing if it is not technically ready.
- Dancers will wear team sweats at all competition/conventions/awards ceremony and other venues when representing BDC.

- Dancers will give all teachers respect during class, by not talking back, coming prepared, having hair secured away from my face and in the proper dance clothes.
- Dancers will respect their teammates by not talking and/or gossiping about each other. This will not be tolerated. We are a team.
- Social media posting without the consent of the person being recorded will not be tolerated. Dancer will not post anything on social media without the consent of the dancer being photographed or recorded.
- Dancers will not go into anyone's locker except their own without permission. Lockers are personal property no one should be touching each other's personal property.

**C. BDC Competition Team Descriptions and Dance Requirements:**

**1. BDC Senior Competition Team ages 14 +**

This is our team for the dancer that excels in all areas of dance, has solid turns, flexibility and can pick up choreography quickly. Solos are by invitation only. Graduating seniors ONLY may have one or two solos choreographed by either a guest choreographer or a BDC teacher. Senior Team will attend 1 in studio dance convention, 1 Ignite Convention & 4 regional competitions and 1 National Competition. This team may be considered for a guest choreographer. This team is typically a level IV and/or V.

## **2. BDC Teen Competition Team (ages 11-14)**

This is our team for the dancer that excels in all areas of dance, has solid turns, flexibility and can pick up choreography quickly. Solos are by invitation only. Teen Solos will compete at the Intermediate or advance level determined by years of training. Teens will attend Quest in studio dance convention, Ignite Dance Convention, 4 regional competitions & 1 national dance competition. This team may be considered for a guest choreographer. This team is typically a level III and/or IV

## **3. BDC Junior Competition Team (ages 9-11)**

This is our team for dancers who excel in all areas of dance & have a strong technique. Solos are by invitation only. Junior Solos will compete at the Intermediate or Advance level determined by years of training. They will attend Quest in studio dance convention, Ignite Dance Convention, 4 regional competitions & 1 national dance competition. These team may be considered for a guest choreographer. This team is typically a Level III.

**A. Payment Policies and Fees:**

All these payments are due in full by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month. If my payments are late by 10 days, I will be charged a \$30 late fee. If your credit card is declined, you will have 2 business days to rectify the situation. If the payment is not rectified your dancer WILL NOT be able to attend classes or rehearsal until you are paid in full.

There will be a \$35 returned check fee.

If you choose to withdraw your dancer for any reason, you **WILL** be subject to a **re-choreography fee of \$250** for extra rehearsals and re-costuming an additional dancer. When joining the team, you are committing to the full year, including recital.

There will be no refunds for missed classes or missed privates. You are responsible for the tuition regardless of absences.

An additional \$7 per entry fee will be added to all competition entries. This is an admin fee to cover the time to enter, change, email and coordinate all things associated with the competition. There will also be a \$20 credit card processing fee per dancer for competition entries. This covers the credit card fees charged by the competitions to register. Any left-over credit card fees will be refunded into your May account

### **A. Solos**

BDC solos are by invitation only. When you receive your email stating your dancer has made one of our teams, there will also be a message if they received a solo or not. If they do receive a solo, you may accept or deny the invitation. If you accept you will also let us know if you would like your dancer to receive weekly or bimonthly privates for their solo. Once you make your decision your dancer will be added to the schedule, and you cannot change. You will only pay for privates when your dancer attends their weekly or bimonthly rehearsal.

If you accept your solo, your dancer will learn the choreography to their solo in August 2026. The solo schedule will be emailed out. Dancers will meet twice with their teacher to learn their choreography. A \$250 fee will be added to your July 2026 account to pay for the solo choreography/music cut. Privates to rehearse your solo will begin in September. I will do my best to schedule your dancer's rehearsal time on a day they are already at the studio.

Solo costumes can be bought on your own. If you are purchasing a costume on your own, it MUST be approved by your dancer's teacher. This will ensure you both have the same vision. Most costumes will be purchased by your dancer's teacher

### **B. Leveled Acro**

We will be leveling our Acro classes for our competition teams' Mini level and higher. Dancers will be tested this summer, June 2<sup>nd</sup> & June 6<sup>th</sup>. See Times at end of document. Dancers must wear all black (Booty shorts/Bra top) no tights, hair in bun or ponytail. **Fee \$15 CASH ONLY.**

Acrobatics Arts is a structured Acro syllabus which prepares a dancer for advance Acro moves through strength, flexibility, and technique. A book with details on skills needed to be in each level will be at the front desk to view prior to the test dates. Students must obtain at least an 85% or higher to be placed into the tested level. It is common for dancers to remain at the same level for 1-3 years.

### **C. BDC Costumes:**

Competition costumes will be no more than \$250. I understand a \$100 per competition costume deposit will be due August 1, 2026. The balance will be collected Oct. 1, 2026. Costumes will be catalog or custom made, and will be used at our 4 regional competitions, 1 National, as well as our 2027 recital.

Required recreational class costumes will be \$95 (child) \$105 (adult) each. I understand that a \$95 or \$105 per costume fee will be due November 1, 2026. Costumes will be used for our recital 2027.

#### **D. Props Building and Transportation**

If a teacher uses a prop in their dance, the fees for building the prop, as well as the transportation of the prop (U-Haul rental/gas), will be evenly split among the dancers in that dance. This fee will be billed to my May 2027 account.

#### **F. BDC Team Sweat, Back packs, Jewelry:**

You are responsible to purchase a BDC team sweat suit and team backpack through BDC. It is mandatory that your child's name be printed on the front.

Team sweats will be used for many years. Team sweat payment of \$240, is due in full July 1, 2026. Team backpack payment of \$90 is due in full July 1, 2026.

We do not supply make up kits anymore, but we will email out recommendations for make-up clinic.

Dancers MUST wear their full team uniform on stage at competition awards ceremony as well as at recital. The other alternative outfit for awards is our pull over windbreaker and team leggings, no exceptions. No eating, drinking or phone usage while on stage for awards.

#### **G. Holiday Lighted Parade**

BDC Competition Team participates in the Lighted Holiday Parade in downtown every season. To dance/participate each dance member needs to have the required sweat outfit, gloves, headband and scarf. The total for the complete package is \$100.

#### **H. Guest Choreographers**

BDC will hire several guest choreographers to work with our competition dancers. These choreographers will create group pieces. Solos are reserved ONLY for graduating seniors. The fees for the choreographers vary depending on their traveling fees and per dance/dancer fee.

You will be responsible to pay the fee up front, it is not part of your monthly group fees. Rehearsals for the group will take place weekly and there is no additional fee for their rehearsal.

If you have a guest choreographer for your solo, you will pay up front for your solo. You will need to either practice on your own or schedule a weekly private with a BDC teacher to run your solo.

#### **I. Nationals**

This season our team will travel to a National Dance Competition. This competition will be for all our teams (not Petites). There will be a mandatory two-week Nationals boot camp required for all dancers prior to attending Nationals. There

will also be a required T shirt all dancers must purchase. Nationals is a week-long event; we will release the date of this and the competition we are attending at our Zoom parent meeting June 8<sup>th</sup>. National entry fees will be due in April 2027.

### **J. In-Studio Dance Convention & Ignite**

BDC will host a 2-day, Quest in-studio dance convention July 18-19th, for dancers on the Mini- Senior team. Times, cost, and class description of the in-studio convention will be released at our ZOOM parent meeting June 8th. It will include 2 days of classes with guest choreographers. More information about teachers will be released at the parent meeting.

The choreographers teaching our in-studio dance convention will also be choreographing a small group, by invitation only. If your dancer is chosen to be in the group, they must attend the rehearsals this week.

[Ignite Dance Convention](#) (register with this link) is a 1-day convention. It allows are dancer to be taught by some great of Michigan choreographers. Laura Standlick, one of our BDC teachers, owns Ignite and we have been attending since the first year. All teams, Mini-Senior, will be required to attend Ignite Dance Convention at Eisenhower High School, Sunday Oct 4th.

### **K. Teaching Assistant Program**

We will begin our teaching assistant program this summer. We will be selecting advanced dancers, ages 12 & Older, to assist in camps or clinics in the summer (2026) and into the full year (2026/2027). If your dancer is interested, please have them fill out the google doc.

### **L. Private Dance Lessons**

Private dance instruction is available at BDC with BDC teachers weekly or bimonthly. To schedule a private please contact the instructor you want to schedule a private with. They will then coordinate times and days which work for both of you as well as available studio space. Fees for privates are \$40 per ½ hour. Only able to schedule if your bill is not past due.

### **M. Closing/Cancellations:**

BDC follows the Lake Orion school district holiday calendar. We do not always follow their school closings due to inclement weather. We alert our team member of studio closures through email as well as posts on social media, Facebook & Instagram. There are no makeup classes for studio closure due to inclement weather or holidays.

### **N. BDC Training ONLY**

If you are a part of our 2026/2027 season you are required to only receive training at BDC. You may not be a part of another competitive team. You may be on a dance team or cheer team. BDC will need to be provided your teams schedule if there are too many dates which conflict with your training at BDC you may have to schedule privates or be dropped from competitive dances.

### **O. Extra Competitions for Soloist**

Dancers who have a solo may compete their solo at additional competitions which do not conflict with BDC's set competitive schedule. Requests to attend that competition should be submitted to Jennifer Adair no later than 45 days BEFORE the competition.

### **P. Sign Up Genius for Title or Extra Comps**

Before each competition Jennifer Adair will create a sign-up genius asking if your dancer would like to be added for Title. Title at a competition is a separate adjudication and results in being crowned a winner or runner up. Only dancers with a solo can run for Title.

### **Q. Fund Raising:**

BDC offers a Booster club for all families at BDC, called Broadway Dance Boosters (BDB). The goal is to raise money to support our dancers.

Participation is individually based and not mandatory. Board elections take place at the beginning of the season. This will be discussed at our new competition parent meeting via Zoom June 8<sup>th</sup>.

### **R. Game Changers or other Gyms**

As a recommendation we ask that if your dancer attends a gym to train in their acro skills, they DO NOT work on skills we do not feel they are ready for. The Acrobatics Arts program we follow allows your dancer to progress at acro skills because they are strong, flexible and ready for the skill, not because they can throw their body in the air. The program is designed for dancers, not gymnastics as we are performing our skills on a hard surface. Injuries occur this way as well as form bad habits.

### **BDC Buddy**

Each dancer will be assigned a dance buddy for the season. Buddies are secretly assigned to our older dancers ages 11+ in early October 2026. For the next 4 weeks, notes, gifts and clues are left at the front desk for the older and younger buddy to give and receive. Finally, on Saturday, November 7<sup>th</sup>, BDC will host a studio party with the full team (Petites included). A reveal is done, and our younger dancers get to meet their BDC Buddy for the season.

Throughout the season Buddy's should attend and watch their BDC Buddy dance at competitions. They should make cards or bring small gifts to celebrate with their BDC Buddy.
