



## **BDC Petite & Mini Handbook 2026/2027**

### **Petite Team**

**Ages 4-5**

Dancers MUST be age 4 or 5, by September 1, 2026. All dancers must be potty trained and able to come into a classroom without the assistance of a caregiver. Petites dance once a week. They take ½ hour acro class and a 1-hour class where they will learn Ballet, Jazz and Tap as well as the choreography for their competition dance. They will compete at 2 regional competitions, with 1 dance.

They are required to take the Petite Class & Petite Acro in the Fall, Summer is optional. There is no audition required, simply sign up and you will be a member of this team.

## **Mini Team**

### **Ages 6-8**

Our Mini Team is designed for dancers ages 6-8, by September 1, 2026. This team must audition on June 2nd to be placed onto this team. The skills needed to be on this team, is flexibility, musicality, and some acro skills. They must also be able to learn and memorize choreography.

The Mini team will dance 3 times a week. Tuesday, Thursday and Saturdays starting in September 2026. They will ALL learn 3 dances. One group dance, one line dance, and a production dance. Some may be invited to be in a small group as well as a solo.

Minis are required to dance in the summer. Summer is 6 weeks you must attend 4 out of the 6 weeks.

Minis are required to attend the Quest in studio convention, as well as Ignite dance convention. They will compete at 4 regional competitions & 1 nationals. Competitions we attend will be discussed at the Zoom parent meeting June 8th.

Solos are by invitation only and will be emailed June 4th with results of your dancer's audition placement. All group placements will be shared after the new parent meeting on Zoom June 8<sup>th</sup>.

## **Mini Solos**

Solos are by invitation only. We take into consideration skills such as maturity, flexibility, memorization skills, etc when deciding who receives a solo.

If your dancer receives a solo invitation, you will learn your solo choreography in August and be billed \$250. You will start weekly or bimonthly privates 15 minutes in length, cost \$20 to rehearse your solo starting in September.

Solo costumes may be up to \$250. You may purchase a solo costume on your own. Please check with your choreographer before making any purchases on your own.

Solo fees are not a part of your monthly set fees listed above.

## **Summer Classes**

Summer class for Minis are required. Tuition for summer classes will be \$300 due June 15th, 2026. Petite Summer dance is optional but highly recommended. If your Petite takes summer classes, they will be taking the Level I classes. Summer tuition for Petites is \$250 and is due June 15, 2026.

Summer classes begin June 16 through July 30th, 6 weeks. Your dancer must attend 4 out of the 6 weeks

## **Holiday Lighted Parade**

BDC participates in [Lake Orion Downtown Holiday Parade](#) every year. All teams participate dancing down the streets of our village. Parade attire is required. Holiday sweatshirt and joggers will be billed to your Nov. Account in the amount of \$100.

## **Attendance**

Attendance is VERY important when being on any team. We cannot advance with the dance when there are missing pieces of the puzzle. If your dancer needs to miss due to a contagious illness they will be excused. They cannot miss due to being tired, not wanting to go, a birthday party, etc.

If you have a planned vacation or other mandatory event, you must fill out an absence notice form, **2 weeks in advance**, so we can prepare for that rehearsal. CLASS will always be held, but if too many dancers miss, REHEARSALS will be cancelled, no refunds will be given.

As a parent it is your responsibility to foster their commitment to a team. We are role models as parents and our kids learn through us. If you choose to make this special team a part of your dancer's year, please explain to them they are committing for the whole process.

**If your dancer misses more than 3 rehearsals, they may be removed from a dance.**

**If your dancer is not at the last rehearsal BEFORE competition they will not be allowed to dance at that competition, no excuses**

## **Props**

If a teacher uses a prop in their dance, the fees for building the prop, as well as the transportation of the prop (U-Haul rental/gas), will be evenly split among the dancers in that dance. This fee will be billed to my May 2027 account.

## **Dress Rehearsal Auditorium Rental**

Each season our team holds a dress rehearsal at Lake Orion High School prior to our 1<sup>st</sup> competition. We do this so our dancers have an opportunity to use the space of

the stage, wear their costume, & practice the hair style and make-up of the season. The cost to rent the auditorium, Marley floor and staff compensation will be evenly split among all team members. This fee will be in your February account.

### **Mini Team Sweats & Backpack**

Team sweats are used at our awards ceremony for each competition. We call them our awards costume. Your dancer must purchase a team jacket and leggings as well as a backpack to be a part of the BDC Competition Team.

Mini /Mini Elite cost for jacket & leggings is \$240 payable July 1, 2026. Cost for the personalized backpack is \$90 payable July 1, 2026.

We no longer have required make up kits, but we will send suggestions we want you to use when applying make-up.

Dancers MUST wear their full team uniform on stage at competition awards ceremony as well as at recital. The other alternative outfit for awards is our pull over windbreaker and team leggings, no exceptions. No eating, drinking or phone usage while on stage for awards.

### **Petite Team Sweats, Backpack & Make up Kit**

Team sweats are used at our awards ceremony for each competition. We call them our awards costume. Your dancer must purchase a BDC Competition Team hoodie, they will pair that with solid black leggings you will purchase on your own.

Petite Hoodies are \$70 and Make up Kits are \$35 due September 1, 2026.

Petite Backpacks are optional, if you do choose to order one cost is \$90 payable by July 1, 2026.

### **Petite Regional Competitions**

Petites will attend 2 regional competitions. Regional competitions take place in the tri county area.

Competitions release their schedule times and lineup **10 days before a competition.** Therefore, you must make sure you are available the entire weekend.

The day of the competition you MUST report to the venue 2 hours prior to your dancer's stage time. This will allow your dancer to get completely dressed, stretched, rehearsed and ready for stage. Most competitions run ahead of schedule too.

## **Mini Regional Competition**

Minis will attend 4 regional competitions. Regional competitions take place in the tri county area.

Competitions release their schedule times and lineup **10 days before a competition.** Therefore, you must make sure you are available the entire weekend.

The day of the competition you MUST report to the venue 2 hours prior to your dancer's stage time. This will allow your dancer to get completely dressed, stretched, rehearsed and ready for stage. Most competitions run ahead of schedule.

## **Mini National Competition**

This season our team will travel to a National Dance Competition. This competition will be for all our team (not Petites). There will be a mandatory two-week Nationals boot camp required for all dancers prior to attending Nationals. There will also be a required T shirt all dancers must purchase. Nationals is a week-long event; we will release the date of this and the competition we are attending at our Zoom parent meeting June 8<sup>th</sup>. **Entry fees for Nationals are NOT included in above statement of fees. National Fees will be due in April 2027.**

## **Competition & Recital Costumes**

Mini dancers will be required to purchase recital costumes. Recital costumes will be \$95 for child size, \$105 for adult sizes. Recital costume fees are due November 1, 2026.

NO ACRO RECITAL DANCE or costume.

## **Leveled Acro**

We will be leveling our Acro classes for our competition teams Mini level and higher. Dancers will be tested this summer, June 2<sup>nd</sup> & June 6<sup>th</sup>. See Times at end of document. Dancers must wear all black hair secured off face in a bun or ponytail. **Testing fee \$15 CASH ONLY.**

Acrobatics Arts is a structured Acro syllabus which prepares a dancer for advance Acro moves through strength, flexibility, and technique. A book with details on skills needed to be in each level will be at the front desk to view prior to the test dates. Students must obtain at least an 85% or higher to be placed into the tested level. It is common for dancers to remain at the same level for 1-3 years.

Mini will be tested for Level acro classes. Petites will NOT be tested.

**Outside Training/Gym Acro**

Dancers who are on the BDC Competition team may not be a part of another studio's competition team.

As a recommendation we ask that if your dancer attends a gym to train in their acro skills, they DO NOT work on skills we do not feel they are ready for. The Acrobatics Arts program we follow allows your dancer to progress at acro skills because they are strong, flexible and ready for the skill, not because they can throw their body in the air. This program is also made for dancers. Injuries occur this way as well as form bad habits.

## **Conventions**

BDC will host a 2-day, Quest in-studio dance convention July 18-19th, for dancers on the Mini- Senior team. Times, cost, and class description of the in-studio convention will be released at our ZOOM parent meeting June 8th. It will include 2 days of classes with guest choreographers. More information about teachers will be released at the parent meeting.

The choreographers teaching our in-studio dance convention will also be choreographing a small group, by invitation only. If your dancer is chosen to be in the group, they must attend the rehearsals this week.

[Ignite Dance Convention](#) (register with this link) is a 1-day convention. It allows a dancer to be taught by some great Michigan choreographers. Laura Standlick, one of our BDC teachers, owns Ignite and we have been attending since the first year. All teams, Mini-Senior, will be required to attend Ignite Dance Convention at Eisenhower High School, Sunday Oct 4th.

## **Closing/Cancellations**

BDC follows the Lake Orion school district holiday calendar. We do not always follow their school closings due to inclement weather. We alert our team members of studio closures through the Remind App. We will also send an email about our closure as well as post on social media, Facebook & Instagram. There are no makeup classes for studio closure due to inclement weather or holidays.

## **BDC Training**

If you are a part of our 2026/2027 season you are required to only receive training at BDC. You may not be a part of another competitive team. You may be on a dance team or cheer team. BDC will need to be provided your teams schedule if there are too many dates which conflict with your training at BDC you may have to schedule privates or be dropped from competitive dances.

## **Payment Policies and Fees**

All mentioned payments are due in full by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month. If your payment is late by 10 days, you will be charged a \$30 late fee. There will be a \$35 returned check fee. There will be no refunds for missed classes. You are responsible for the tuition regardless of absences.

If that credit card is declined, you will have 2 business days to rectify the situation. If it is not rectified your dancer will not be able to attend class or rehearsal until payment is received in full.

**\*NEW\*** a 3% surcharge will be added to all monthly fees if using a credit card to pay your tuition or any other fees to BDC. Every account will receive a 3% surcharge. If you decide to pay by cash or check, the surcharge will be removed.

### **Fund Raising**

BDC offers a Booster club for all families at BDC. Broadway Dance Boosters (BDB) is a parent run club which provides opportunities for your family to help pay down your dance bill through fundraising events they host. Their primary goal is to raise money to support our dancers.

Participation is individually based and not mandatory. Board elections take place at the beginning of the season. More information will be presented at our ZOOM Competition Parent Meeting June 8<sup>th</sup> times TBA.

### **BDC Buddy**

Each dancer will be assigned a dance buddy for the season. Buddies are secretly assigned to our older dancers ages 11+ in early October 2026. For the next 4 weeks, notes, gifts and clues are left at the front desk for the older and younger buddy to give and receive. Finally, on Saturday, November 7<sup>th</sup>, BDC will host a studio party with the full team (Petites included). A reveal is done, and our younger dancers get to meet their BDC Buddy for the season.

Throughout the season Buddy's should attend and watch their BDC Buddy dance at competitions. They should make cards or bring small gifts to celebrate with their BDC Buddy.

### **Auditions/Placements**

Dancers should wear comfortable dance clothes, bring their turners, or jazz shoes, and have their hair secured away from their face.

Dancers will arrive 10 minutes before their audition time to receive an audition number. They will then warm up, learn a short combination and finally we will place them into groups of 5/6 to audition the combination they just learned. We start from the youngest to the oldest. During the audition we ask them to also show us their leaps, turns, flexibility and acro skills. Based on their auditions we then will place them onto the team they will best fit.

When you will receive an email with your dancer's team placement for the new season. On June 8<sup>th</sup> we will hold a Mandatory New Season Parent meeting on Zoom. Link Provided when you accept your position on the team.
